Nihongo Center Terms of Enrollment

Article 1: Enrollment Procedures

Applicants must submit the specified application documents and pay the ① Screening Fee.

Enrollment is established upon the issuance of the Certificate of Eligibility (CoE) and the completion of all enrollment procedures.

Article 2: Breakdown of Fees and Refund Policy

The fees for enrollment are as follows: ② Enrollment Fee ③ Tuition Fee ④ Textbook Fee ⑤ Facilities Fee ⑥ Utilities Fee

The above fees are calculated and collected based on the school's regulations and cancellation policy.

Article 3: Handling of Fees upon Cancellation or Withdrawal

If an applicant or current student cancels or withdraws, a refund will be processed in accordance with the "Cancellation Policy."

As a general rule, any bank transfer fees incurred for the refund will be borne by the applicant.

Article 4: Nature of the Enrollment Fee and Screening Fee

The Enrollment Fee is the consideration for the right to enroll and, as a general rule, is non-refundable.

The Screening Fee is the consideration for the enrollment screening process and is non-refundable, except in cases where the process has not yet been initiated.

Article 5: Cancellation due to Force Majeure

In the event that it becomes impossible to come to Japan or enroll due to force majeure, such as a natural disaster, epidemic, or administrative measures, a refund will be issued after deducting any actual costs incurred, to the extent possible.

Article 6: Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

These terms and conditions shall be governed by the laws of Japan. In the event of any dispute, the Kyoto District Court shall be the court of exclusive jurisdiction for the first instance.

Note

The school offers either a 2-year Intensive Japanese Course (starting in April) or a 1.5-year Intensive Japanese Course (starting in October). Completion for both courses is in March of the year two years after the start date. Leaving a course partway through will be treated as a withdrawal. Please note that a 6-month course is not available.

The graduation requirements are as follows:

From April: 2-year Intensive Japanese Course: Japanese Reference Framework B2 level (JLPT N2)

From October: 1.5-year Intensive Japanese Course: Japanese Reference Framework B1 level (JLPT N3)
